

### National Youth Day - 2026


Date of Event: 12<sup>th</sup> December 2026

- Government Engineering College, Ambikapur organized the National Youth Day (Yuva Diwas) Celebration 2026 on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026 in accordance with the guidelines issued by the All-India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). 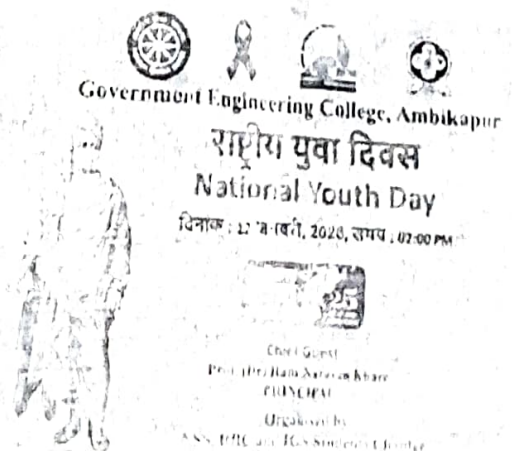
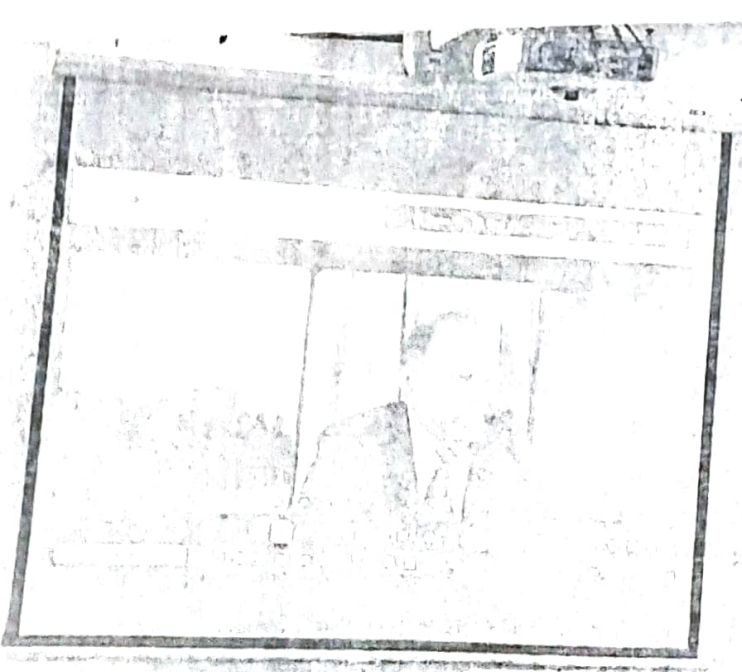
